The event was a huge success. The initial goal of \$27,000 was reached and even largely exceeded, with a total of \$30,515!

Several social clubs from the community and some donors came on the air to present the amounts that they collected through various fundraising activities.

To encourage people to make a donation of \$25 or more, the Restigouche Automobile Dealers Association sponsored not one but two **iPad Air 2** tablets that were randomly drawn at the end of the day.
